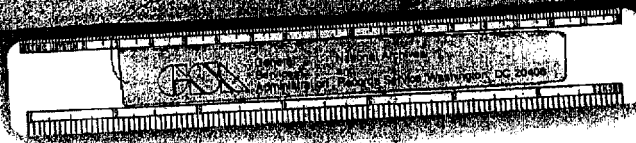

DESIGN FOR PRINTERS' TYPE.

TO ALL WHOM IT MAY CONCERN:

Be it known that I, JULIUS HERRIET, of the city of New York, in the county of New York, and State of New York, have originated and designed a new Pattern for Printing Types, which I call Ornamental Antique Shaded lower-case letters and figures, reference being had to the annexed printed impression thereof.
