DESIGN FOR A FONT OF PRINTING-TYPE.

SPECIFICATION forming part of Design No. 15,791, dated February 10, 1885.

Application filed January 14, 1885. Term of patent 14 years.

To all whom it may concern:

Be it known that I, HERMAN HILENBURG, (assignor to MACKELLAR, SMITHS & JORDAN,) of the city and county of Philadelphia, Pennsylvania, have invented a new Design for a Font of Printing-Type, of which the following is a specification.

The nature of my design is clearly shown in the accompanying typographic impression, to which reference is made; and it consists of a letter resembling the class known as "antique," shaded upon the right and below by a light line and ornamented by a ground-work of light leaf-like ornaments.

The character of the design is preserved in the numerals.

In connection with the font are shown a series of ornamental affixes, numbered from 1 to 9, and reference is made to the typographic impression, which shows the exact configuration of the same.

Having now described my invention, I claim as new—

The design for a font of printing-type, substantially as shown and described.
